According to the Assessors office these 3 minor errors did not cause assessment problems.

WHEREAS, the COMMISSIONERS of OKANOGEN FFD 16 has met and considered

BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the taxing district that an increase in the regular property tax levy is hereby authorized for the levy to be collected in the 2011 tax year.

additional revenue resulting from new construction, improvements to property, newly constructed wind turbines, any increase in the value of state assessed property, any annexations that have occurred and refunds made.
